

TVØROYRI



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Hiking trails around Tvøroyri

- 1** Áargøtan, the river path follows the river Stórá for approx. 2 km, with the option to do a 4,2 km roundtrip on a single lane road.
- 2** Hvannahagi - a popular mountain walk approx. 4,2 km back and forth. The single lane access road is 1,4 km.
- 3** Kikarin, a 1,1 km long walk to a breathtaking viewpoint with a pair of the tourist binoculars (roundtrip 2,2 km)
- 4** Níðan á Nakk - walking 2,9 km along the old road up to a beautiful viewpoint (roundtrip 5,8 km)
- 5** Kambur - an 3,6 km easy hike along a tractor track to the top of Kambur
- 6** Rangabotnur - an easy 1,8 km walk up to some old coalmines and a beautiful view
- 7** Gluggarnir - demanding 2,2 km hike to the highest point in Suðuroy, Gluggarnir, 610 meters above sea level.
- 8** Trongisvágur to Hvalba - a 5,5 km hike along the old trail between the villages
- 9** Trongisvágur to Fámjin - a 4,6 km hike along the old trail between villages - optional hike to the top of Oyrnafjall, 443 meters above sea level.
- 10** Øravík to Fámjin - a 4,6 km hike along the old trail between the villages
- 11** Øravík to Fámjin - a 5 km hike along the old trail between the villages - with a connection to the southern part of the island

Difficulty:

Trails

- Easy - along road or footpath
- Fairly easy mountain walk
- Demanding mountain hike along old trails
- Difficult mountain hike in steep terrain
